

How to fill in a scorecard for a Stableford competition

8. Write the name/number/type of competition (ie Stableford# 49)

6. Fill in the date and your tee time

14. Write your name and your handicap in the relevant boxes

10. You should then exchange cards with one of your playing partners

5. Once the round has started, record your score in the marker's column on the left hand side of the card with your Stableford score to the side

15. Check the score you have recorded for your playing partner to confirm it matches his figures in his 'marker's column'

1. Mytime often run a 2's competition. If you have entered this and managed to score only two shots on a hole, please mark the number of holes you have achieved this in the box next to your Stableford score

3. Record the Stableford score in the box found in the bottom left hand corner of the scorecard

9. Once you are agreed that the score has been recorded correctly, you should sign as the marker, and hand the card back to your playing partner

7. Put a ring around, or tick the colour of the tee you are playing from. Almost all club competitions will be played from the white tees

16. Write the number of strokes your playing partner has taken in column 'A'. Their Stableford points score (please ask for advice if you are unsure how the Stableford system works) should be recorded in the right hand column

4. When you have completed your game, add up the total of each half of the round, add these two figures together.

13. Any mistakes on the card should be corrected (line through the original entry) and the correct score initialled by the marker

2. If you are unsure how to calculate your nett score, the minimum information you have to record is your gross score. It is helpful to those organising the competition if you can calculate your Stableford points

Please note that you will be disqualified from the competition if you do not sign and return your card, and as a minimum, you must record your gross score.

11. If you are happy that your card is correct, you should sign the card, and return it to the organising committee (usually by posting the card in the competitions box in the corridor)
